I am pleased to submit my manuscript entitled, “Qualitative analysis of dysfunctional eating behavior in lesbian, bisexual and transgender women” to your journal.


The article integrates the highly active literature on vulnerability of gender identity as it relates to their choices regarding their own body, and subsequent health choices. Women in general tend to have a dysfunctional relationship with food, adding identity choices to the debate only makes eating behavior more deficient. We describe a qualitative study interviewing ten people (4 bisexual genders, and 2 transgender) to discuss their perception of heteronormative standards, difficult relationship with food, satisfaction with the body, difficulty in relationships, feelings and/or emotions.

The manuscript is original, not previously published, and not under concurrent consideration elsewhere.
